GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE NATURE, USE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PRODUCT

During the development and manufacture of the product we are using the original technological principles proven by long tradition, complemented by the latest knowledge in the field of design and technology. Thanks to this approach our products have received many awards on the domestic and also international markets. Each product also undergoes specific durability tests in accordance with European standard EN 16 139.

The majority of our products is manufactured from natural materials such as wood, leather, cotton etc.. That's why you can find wooden parts with the natural growth characteristics which could cause different absorption of the finishing material/stain, changes in texture and colour differences. Wood as a natural material constantly breathes and reacts to the surrounding environment. Thanks to this, small hairline cracks in the paint or slight penetration of the wood structure on the surface can appear during the lifetime of the product. Also natural leather may have an uneven surface structure, minor scars and abrasions that have arisen during the life of the animal.

In any case this is not a defect, just the opposite. With every product you receive unique and original piece of furniture created by human hands. You can be sure that no one else will have the same chair like you. Extreme environmental effects are detrimental not only to people but also to furniture made of natural materials. Abnormal relative humidity (lower than 40% or conversely higher than 60%) can have a negative impact on the product and cause shape distortion or damage of the upholstery.

If the product is exposed to direct sunlight or other heat source (fireplace, stove, heating etc.), upholstery material or colour wood finish can be prone to cracking or shade changes, after some time the colour shade of the wood and upholstery material will be changed. It is a common phenomenon which we find anywhere in the environment of our lives.

Some kind of material tension may occur on parts which are made by unique bending technology. This may cause slight wobbling of the product, which you shall not consider as a defect because this issue is eliminated by the sitting. Swivel armchairs collection with the code 503, 505 and 523 are being supplied with simple steel hardware enabling the rotation and height adjustability. Rotation is always accompanied with the height adjustment. However, there is no mechanical border to prevent the turning to come over the maximum seat height (68 cm). Further rotation may cause the fall of the seat.

MAINTENANCE OF LACQUERED WOODEN PARTS OF THE PRODUCT

Dust the wooden parts of the product with a soft, clean and dry cloth. Use a cleaning detergent designated for matt painted furniture in case of more extensive staining. We recommend the cleaning detergent Poliboy, PH neutral, based on natural, biodegradable tensides, which ensures wood and skin friendly maintenance. Strictly adhere to the label instructions for use of the purchased detergent.

MAINTENANCE OF FURNITURE WITH OIL TREATED SURFACE

Dust from wooden parts of the furniture treated by oil shall be cleaned by dry or softly wet microfibre cloth. If more thorough cleaning is necessary, use a mild detergent solution and wipe it dry. Oil treated furniture is resistant to common liquids used in households and restaurants, but do not let them be too long on the product.

To revive and maintain worn places of furniture we recommend using OSMO TOP oil - shade 3058, transparent, with wax. In case of more extensive staining or mechanical damage (scratches), use a fine-grained sandpaper and treat the

furniture with a fine layer of OSMO TOP oil afterwards. Wipe off the remaining oil and let it dry.

MAINTENANCE OF UPHOLSTERED PARTS

Fabrics and Eco-Leather

You can increase the useful life of covering fabric by regular treatment and cleaning. Remove dust with a fine brush or vacuum cleaner. Larger stains should be removed by shampooing with foam, which should not come into contact with the wooden parts of the product. Proceed carefully to prevent the cleaning solution from penetrating and soaking into the fabric. Proceed with shampooing in compliance with the instruction for use by the manufacturer of the detergent. Never use the agents containing benzene and other solvents. We recommend cleaning stains on all covering fabrics before they get dry; you can improve cleaning efficiency.

Never rub the stains; drain them with a clean cloth. Eco-leather may only be cleaned using lukewarm water and common soap agents. Take care to prevent the water to come into contact with the wooden parts of the product.

Natural Leather

Remove dust with a vacuum cleaner or a damp cotton cloth. Never let stains dry and remove them immediately. Liquids can be dried out by a paper towel. For more extensive staining use a sponge soaked in distilled water and gently remove the stain by circular motion, do not press. Afterwards, dry the place with a cotton cloth. When the liquid is absorbed by the leather, you might not be able to remove the stain. Do complete cleaning and preservation of leather with special agents 2-4 times a year according to the intensity of usage. Observe the instructions specified by the manufacturer.

OTHER PARTS OF THE FURNITURE

Remove dust from cane parts with a vacuum cleaner and damp cloth. Clean



the metal and plastic parts of the furniture with water containing detergents; dry immediately and shine with soft cloth. In the case of more extensive staining use cleaning detergent designed for metal or plastic. Strictly adhere to the label instructions for use of the purchased detergent.

ASSEMBLY OF FURNITURE

During the assembly of furniture follow the Assembly Instructions.

Make the assembly of tables directly in the original packaging, which is protected by soft PE pad. This way you can avoid mechanical damage of the table top. After completing of the assembly take the table out of the carton box and place it on legs. It is recommended to perform this operation by the number of persons listed in the Assembly Instruction otherwise legs can be damaged during the handling.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

We recommend to check and tighten periodically all screws and bolts which are used to connect individual parts. This will result in increased overall strength and durability of the product. Bigger clearance in the joints can cause excessive strain on parts and cause damage to the product.

We recommend to check on the condition of glides from time to time to avoid a damage of the floor or the product.

Slight ripples and wrinkles can appear on upholstered products during the upholstery process or during the use of the product. These ripples or wrinkles can be determined by the characteristic of upholstery materials or technology of the upholstery and therefore cannot be subject to any claim.

Light colours of fabrics, ECO and natural leathers can be stained when in contact with other materials (non-colourfast textiles, denim, newspapers, magazines etc.). Staining by chemical reaction of colour pigments is not a sign of low quality of upholstery materials and therefore cannot be covered by warranty or reclaimed.

Please keep in mind that as a result of UV radiation and oxidation reactions

there may occur colour differences on tops which are used as an insertion for folding tables (stored under the table top).

At the end of the furniture's service life, handle it as waste, i.e. transfer the waste to an authorised person who will ensure its ecologically compatible disposal.

We kindly ask you to follow instructions and recommendations contained in this manual. Regular professional care extends the life of your product and besides can be also a condition for warranty compensations. The manufacturer does not take any responsibility for potential damage to the product resulting from unauthorised use and unprofessional handling of the furniture.
